Outdoor Movie COVID-19 Rules for the Outdoor Movie

These rules are to ensure the safety of all users and to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

Entrance Restrictions and Requirements

- Self-screen. If you are experiencing any of the following you are prohibited from attending the outdoor movie:
 - \circ $\,$ Symptoms of COVID-19 as listed on Health Unit website.
 - \circ Close contact with a confirmed or probable COVID-19 case.
 - \circ $\,$ Travel outside of Canada in the past 14 days.
 - Instructions from local public health authorities to self-isolate due to travel or contact history.
- Notify the Town of Minto if you test positive for COVID-19, come into close contact with a confirmed or probable COVID-19 case or have been asked to self-isolate by public health authorities.
- Volunteers will complete attendance for the event at the gate.
- Follow protocols required by the province, health unit, and any other regulatory body.

Physical Distancing

- Maintain a distance of at least 2 metres or 6 feet from other people (excluding members of the same household) whenever possible.
- Social circles will be identified for patrons who choose to sit-in and are limited to those in the same household.
- Drive-in patrons must park at least 2 metres or 6 feet from other vehicles; volunteers will direct traffic to ensure vehicles are properly distanced.
- No handshaking, no socializing after the show and no unnecessary physical contact.

Equipment & Structures and Objects

- Sit-in patrons must bring in their own chairs and blankets.
- The structures and objects in and around this amenity are not being sanitized.
- Washrooms at the pavilion and arena will be available for use during the show; cleaning and sanitizing of the facilities will be performed periodically.

Hand Hygiene

- Hand sanitizer will be available at the washrooms and concession stand.
- Hands should be wiped clean before applying the hand sanitizer.
- Perform hand hygiene upon arrival and departure.

Face Masks and Coverings

• Wearing a mask or facial covering is required when patrons are within two metres (six feet) from another person from a different household.

Subject to Change

- These rules are subject to change.
- The show may be cancelled if unsafe physical distancing is observed.

Assumption of Risk

• By visiting any parks and publicly accessible spaces you voluntarily assume all risks including any risk of injury, loss, damage, and possible exposure to a communicable disease, including COVID-19.
